Water

- Universal testing of all private wells \$
- State Lab pay for testing for any water sample sent in
- Fluoridation
- Testing water in schools and daycares \$
- State will pay to replace all lead service lines \$\$\$\$

Food

- Local sources farmed foods in schools - ? \$\$
- Create a food safety program for schools and daycares
- Testing for pesticides \$

Labeling

- Better labeling of allergens \$\$
- Harmful child products \$

Asthma

- Mandatory emissions testing \$
- Idle free zones
- Ban old cars and school buses
- Mandatory electric school buses \$?
- Allow inhalers and sunscreen at schools and daycares
- Allow school staff to administer inhalers and sunscreen
- Require school nurses at public and private schools – full time \$\$\$\$
 - Allow school nurse to administer epi pens and over the counter medications
 - AEDs
- Smoke free and aerosol free in public areas

Anti-preemption language: This is the base, local jurisdictions can have stricter rules.

Physical activity

- Allow safe active transportation to school –
Encourage Safe Routes to School
(Neighborhood Schools)
- Money – Funding source? General funds, fees, taxes, federal money
